SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER


For the past five weeks we, the long baptised and the newly baptised, have been relishing life in the Spirit, though we have yet to read Luke's account of the first outpouring of the Spirit. That will come in two weeks' time on Pentecost Sunday. Today we anticipate the story of the original event by hearing of a later "Pentecost" — but one with a difference. This time the gift of the Spirit is poured out on pagans, and a new era in the mission of the Church is launched.

All the baptised share in this mission, as Pope Francis wrote in *The Joy of the Gospel*: "In virtue of their baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples. All the baptised, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelisation ..."

Pope Francis' appeal continues to ring in our ears: "Let us not allow ourselves to be robbed of missionary enthusiasm."


HERITAGE MARKER HONOURS PARISH

A heritage marker erected by the City of Stirling last year has been relocated to a more prominent position at the request of the parish priest Fr Peter Hoang.

It is now embedded in clear view in the footpath immediately adjacent to the steps that lead to the church from street level.

The inscription on the marker pays tribute to the elegance and craftsmanship of the church building and to the valued presence of the Dominican parish precinct to the local community.
