# OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY

The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (7 October) is a memorial of the Virgin Mary as honoured in the Rosary, a form of prayer combining the salutation of the angel (Luke 1:28) with meditation on the saving mysteries of Christ.

Our Lady's rosary is a precious prayer, a popular gift, and a constant feature of Christian religious devotion. It contemplates the great moments of Christ's life, and in so doing, leads us into the mystery of our life. It describes the joys and sorrows of life, and gives us the promise of eternal glory. Life is a journey that begins in God and which leads to God. It is a deep and abiding mystery which unfolds as we journey along. Jesus Himself is our light - the way, the truth and the life — who leads us on the journey of faith and we travel together. Our life is full of joys and sorrows, and in praying the Rosary we find help and consolation from these same experiences in the lives of Jesus and Mary. The quiet repetition of the "Hail Mary", acting like a mantra, can sooth the spirit into silent contemplation and bring us close to the Lord.
