

A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

Jesus said to his disciples: 'I say this to you who are listening: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who treat you badly. To the man who slaps you on one cheek, present the other cheek too; to the man who takes your cloak from you, do not refuse him your tunic. Give to everyone who asks you, and do not ask for your property back from the man who robs you. Treat others as you would like them to treat you. If you love those who love you, what thanks can you expect? Even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you what thanks can you expect? For even sinners do that much. And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive, what thanks can you expect? Even sinners lend to sinners to get back the same amount. Instead, love your enemies and do good, and lend without any hope of return. You will have a great reward, and you will be sons of the Most High, for he himself is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked.

'Be compassionate as your Father is compassionate. Do not judge and you will not be judged yourselves; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned yourselves; grant pardon, and you will be pardoned. Give, and there will be gifts for you: a full measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over, will be poured into your lap; because the amount you measure out is the amount you will be given back.

COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL

As followers of Christ we have a choice always before us; to live our lives and respond to our world in measure that might seem just and ordered in the 'worldly sense' or to live our lives and respond to our world with an over-abundant love. This is, as the Gospel reading indicates, particularly difficult when we experience hate and destructive forces. Yet, in these times, it is more important still.

The World Day of Prayer is an ecumenical prayer movement developed from a Christian women's perspective as a creative response to issues of concern around the world.

1927 marks the first official World Day of Prayer in countries around the globe.

Every year the worship service focuses on a different country and a specific theme.


