## **A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE**

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit through the wilderness, being tempted there by the devil for forty days. Twelve-year-old Thandolwayo would walk seven kilometres each day to collect contaminated water for her family. It looked like she would never realise her hope of finishing her education and becoming a nurse, until a Caritas Australia supported project created access to clean water helping Thandolwayo to stay at school and achieve a future full of hope.



"Now I can bathe every day, the distance to collect water for the family has been drastically reduced," Thandolwayo says. "We now drink clean, safe water and diseases no longer affect us."
