A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

Jesus said to his disciples: 'You see how it is written that the Christ would suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, and that, in his name, repentance for the forgiveness of sins would be preached to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses to this.

'And now I am sending down to you what the Father has promised. Stay in the city then, until you are clothed with the power from on high.' Then he took them out as far as the outskirts of Bethany, and lifting up his hands he blessed them. Now as he blessed them, he withdrew from them and was carried up to heaven. They worshipped him and then went back to Jerusalem full of joy; and they were continually in the Temple praising God.

COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL

The disciples, upon the ascent of Jesus, are filled with joy, and pay homage. The followers of Jesus are assured that they remain within the mind and heart of God. They have their ears opened to hear that God has always held them in the divine plan found in the scriptures. There is a sense here of the pair of disciples on the way to Emmaus (Lk 24:13-35), whose hearts burn as Jesus interprets the scriptures for them. The disciples are assured that repentance has been won, and they are witnesses to this. The Spirit is to be sent upon them, and they are blessed in the Ascension itself. As Jesus ascends, the blessing reveals that his thoughts are towards them and not himself. The joy of the disciples is reminiscent of the joy of John the Baptist who leapt for joy while in the womb, knowing that the promisee would be fulfilled. [Excerpt from Pastoral Liturgy']
