A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN

Jesus said to his disciples:

'I still have many things to say to you but they would be too much for you now. But when the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth, since he will not be speaking as from himself but will say only what he has learnt; and he will tell you of the things to come. He will glorify me since all he tells you will be taken from what is mine. Everything the Father has is mine; that is why I said:

All he tells you will be taken from what is mine.'

COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL

The brief and bare introduction to today's gospel—"Jesus said to his disciples"— gives no clue to the setting in which these words are spoken, yet it is all important. This passage is an excerpt from Jesus' lengthy conversation with his disciples on the night before he died. His words are characterised by an extraordinary dual intimacy—between Jesus and his companions and between Jesus and his God.

These features are evident in the few verses of this reading. Jesus assures his friends, who are distressed by his talk of leaving, that in his place they will have the Holy Spirit to guide them. The Spirit will keep Jesus' teaching alive in their midst and lead them to the fullness of truth. This work of the Spirit can be seen in the conclusions of the great Church councils that make explicit what Jesus alludes to here: that Father, Son and Spirit enjoy an unrestricted and dynamic communion of being and activity as one God and three Persons. ['Break Open the Word']
