

# A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

Jesus made the crowds welcome and talked to them about the kingdom of God; and he cured those who were in need of healing.

It was late afternoon when the Twelve came to him and said, 'Send the people away, and they can go to the villages and farms round about to find lodging and food; for we are in a lonely place here. He replied, 'Give them something to eat vourselves.' But they said, 'We have no more than five loaves and two fish, unless we are to go ourselves and buy food for all these people.' For there were about five thousand men. But he said to his disciples, 'Get them to sit down in parties of about fifty.' They did so and made them all sit down. Then he took the five loaves and the two fish, raised his eyes to heaven, and said the blessing over them; then he broke them and handed them to his disciples to distribute among the crowd. They all ate as much as they wanted, and when the scraps remaining were collected they filled twelve baskets.

### **COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL**

In the gospel reading, we can recognise that God wants us to be involved; to be receivers of the blessing to be sure but, also, to be sharers in the act of blessing. Further, just as Christ did not ask the disciples to give what they did not have, so too we approach the Eucharist as we are with what little we can bring. Thus, in the wonderful mystery of the Body and Blood of Christ, we also offer to God our efforts and labours, even when they seem entirely inadequate, and we allow Christ to bless them and make them more than enough for ourselves and for those around us. ### **SPECIAL FEAST DAYS**

## June 24: THE NATIVITY OF ST JOHN THE BAPTIST

Celebrating a saint's birthday is something the Church hardly ever does. Generally it is the saint's death (their birth into eternal life) that is observed in the Church's calendar.

This makes John the Baptist a member of a very exclusive nativity club indeed. The other members are Mary, the Mother of Jesus (September 8), and no less than Jesus himself (December 25). The celebration of the Baptist's birth (a Solemnity) far outranks that of his martyrdom (a memorial August 29).

The preface for today tells us - "His birth brought great rejoicing; even in the womb he leapt for joy at the coming of human salvation."

## June 28: THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

This devotion dates back to the Middle Ages. It recalls the mystery of God who is love, and honours the heart of Jesus as the source and centre of the incarnate love of God.

### June 29: SAINTS PETER AND PAUL

This date commemorates the martyrdoms of Peter the 'Chief of the apostles' and Paul the 'apostle to the Gentiles'. Both died as martyrs at Rome under Nero, between 64-67. They are remembered for their faith, their courage, and their leadership during the difficult days of the birth of the Church.


