## **A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE**

As The Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them out ahead of him, in pairs, to all the towns and places he himself was to visit. He said to them, 'The harvest is rich but the labourers are few, so ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers to his harvest. Start off now, but remember, I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. Carry no purse, no haversack, no sandals. Salute no one on the road. Whatever house you go into, let your first words be, "Peace to this house!" And if a man of peace lives there, your peace will go and rest on him; if not, it will come back to you. Stay in the same house, taking what food and drink they have to offer, for the labourer deserves his wages; do not move from house to house. Whenever you go into a town where they make you welcome, eat what is set before you. Cure those in it who are sick, and say, "The kingdom of God is very near to you."

But whenever you enter a town and they do not make you welcome, go out into its streets and say, "We wipe off the very dust of your town that clings to our feet, and leave it with you. Yet be sure of this: the kingdom of God is very near." I tell you, on that day it will not go as hard with Sodom as with that town.'

The seventy-two came back rejoicing. 'Lord,' they said, 'even the devils submit to us when we use your name. He said to them, 'I watched Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Yes, I have given you power to tread underfoot serpents and scorpions and the whole strength of the enemy; nothing shall ever hurt you. Yet do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you; rejoice rather that your names are written in heaven.'

## PAYING RESPECTS TO JOHN KOBELKE

More than 600 mourners packed our parish church on Thursday for a Requiem Mass and funeral of John Kobelke, retired MP and much-admired community leader. A parliamentary eulogy was delivered by Police Minister Michelle Roberts. Family members also spoke fondly of John's life and contribution in many fields. The mourners included the Governor of WA, Kim Beazley, the Premier, Mark McGowan, and the Opposition Leader, Liza Harvey. Among other attendees were members of the Fremantle Sailing Club, current and former ministers and MPs, senior public servants, service group members and many parishioners. They heard tributes to John's tireless support for social justice causes, his love of WA especially its bush and oceans, his decency and loyalty, his integrity and a lifetime of giving and sharing love and hope. Mass was concelebrated by Monsignor Kevin Long and our acting parish priest Fr Chinh. John died on 23 June aged 69 after a brief illness.
