# **SPECIAL FEAST DAYS**

**JULY 22: SAINT MARY MAGDALENE** St. Mary Magdalene is a legendary example of God's mercy and grace. The precise dates of her birth and death are unknown, but we do know she was present with Christ during his public ministry, death and resurrection. She is mentioned at least a dozen times in the Gospels.

# JULY 25: SAINT JAMES, APOSTLE

Born at Bethsaida in Galilee, a son of Zebedee, Saint James died around the year 44. He was the first apostle to die, beheaded by Herod. He was a fisherman who was summoned by Jesus together with his brother Saint John. They were called the "Sons of Thunder". He is remembered as a favoured apostle. With Saint Peter and Saint John he was present at the transfiguration, the raising of the daughter of Jairus and the agony in the garden.

## JULY 26: SAINTS JOACHIM AND ANNE

Saints Joachim and Anne are named as Mary's parents in a late second century tradition. The feast of Saint Anne was kept in Rome from the eighth century, and that of Saint Joachim from the fifteenth century. The feast honours the parents of the Virgin Mary and grandparents of the Lord.
