STATEMENT ON CARDINAL PELL

**By the Most Rev Timothy Costelloe SDB
Archbishop of Perth
Wednesday 21 August 2019**

Following Cardinal Pell's unsuccessful appeal against his conviction on charges of historic sexual abuse of minors, reactions will be varied. Those who have been convinced of his guilt will believe that justice has been served. Those who have always accepted Cardinal Pell's consistent insistence of his innocence of all charges will be dismayed that his appeal has been rejected.

Many people have commented on the conduct of the investigation, trial and conviction of Cardinal Pell. I will not do so. Rather, I would appeal to everyone to remain calm, measured and compassionate in our reactions and responses.

I would also plead with everyone in our society to join in a common effort to eradicate the scourge of sexual abuse from our communities and our institutions. This is what our children and people need from us at this time.

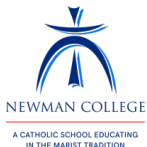
