ALL SAINTS

The Feast of All Saints originated in the East early in the fifth century as a commemoration of all martyrs. It was celebrated in Rome two centuries later but only became established on this date sometime in the papacy of Gregory III (731-741).

Today's Solemnity goes hand in hand with tomorrow's Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. On All Saints' Day we celebrate the glory of all God's holy ones, all those who have entered heaven, including saints who are recognised by the Church and those who are not.

NEW ROOFING TOPS CHURCH REPAIRS

The removal of 30-year-old leaky roofing materials, headlines progress on our parish church's renovation and improvement project this week.

Work started on Wednesday 28 October on installing a new roof. Access to the church precinct was restricted due to the deployment of a giant crane to assist with the job. The same limitations will apply this coming Wednesday.

The project is being undertaken by Colli Constructions under the direction of its principal Peter Colli.

An essential upgrade of the building's electrical systems is advancing well.

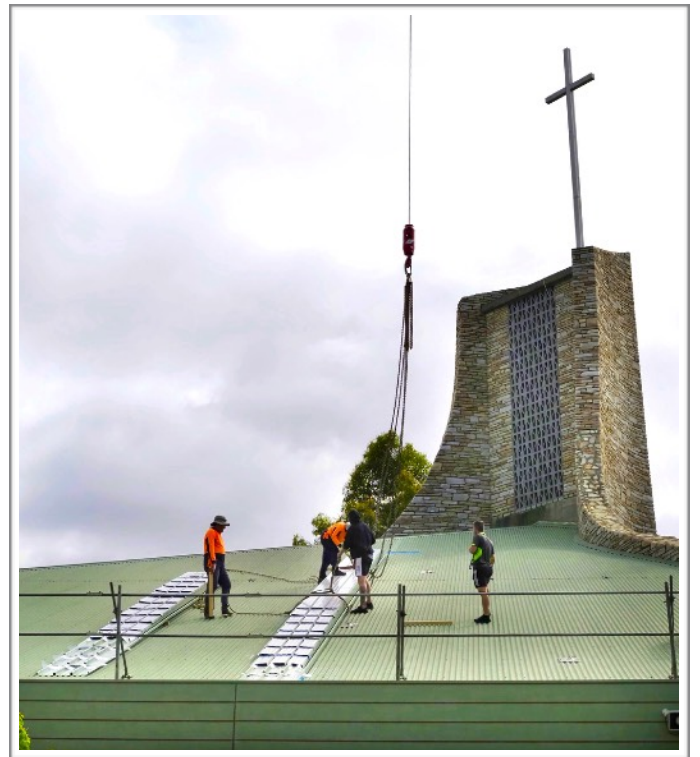
Other elements of the project include the installation of air conditioning, an upgrade of audio-visual systems and the introduction of solar energy panels on the new roof.

The new roofing materials avoid joints which let in water during heavy rainfall. They feature an overlocking clipping system instead. This will overcome the perennial problem of a leaking ceiling in the church.



The renovation and improvement program is designed to ensure the longevity of the building and make it safer for all occupants.

The work is being fully funded by the Our Lady of the Rosary Foundation which maintains a trust funded by bequests and generous donations directed towards the preservation of the church and the needs of the parish community. Work is expected to be completed before Christmas.
