FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT



In the gospel today Jesus issues an urgent call for his listeners to be vigilant, to be awake and ready for the day of the Lord. The call to watch out for the coming of the Lord may seem like a threat, but is meant to challenge us to be fully alive in the here and now.

The First Sunday of Advent repeats the invitation Paul gave to the Corinthians to be thankful for "all the graces you have received through Jesus Christ" and to be "steady and without blame until the last day."

**A READING FROM THE HOLY
GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MARK**

Jesus said to his disciples: 'Be on your
guard stay awake, because you never
know when the time will come. It is like a
man travelling abroad: he has gone from
home, and left his servants in charge,
each with his own task; and he has told
the doorkeeper to stay awake. So stay
awake, because you do not know when
the master of the house is coming,
evening, midnight, cockcrow, dawn;
if he comes unexpectedly, he must not
find you asleep. And what I say to you I
say to all: Stay awake!'

RESILIENCE REVEALED IN PARISH AGM

Reporting on the health of the parish was welcomed by attendees of the annual general meeting last Sunday.

Fr Peter said the parish had emerged well from the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic and the forced changes it had brought. He reported a sound but gradual resumption of normal activities.

He particularly drew attention to the strength of relationships in the wider parish community which included the parish schools and aged care establishments.

Progress on renovations to the church was applauded, with a pre-Christmas completion well in sight.

Pastoral Associate Kaye Shervington reflected on a successful sacramental program in the face of COVID-induced changes.

Finance committee chair John Mordini reported a healthy surplus for the parish due to a number of factors including gifts and lower running expenses.

The Rosary Garden is complete. The project was funded entirely from donations, with about \$20,000 remaining for future projects around the church.
