## **A READING FROM THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES**

As Peter reached the house Cornelius went out to meet him, knelt at his feet and prostrated himself. But Peter helped him up. 'Stand up', he said 'I am only a man after all!'

Then Peter addressed them: 'The truth I have now come to realise' he said 'is that God does not have favourites, but that anybody of any nationality who fears God and does what is right is acceptable to him.'

While Peter was still speaking the Holy Spirit came down on all the listeners. Jewish believers who had accompanied Peter were all astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit should be poured out on the pagans too, since they could hear them speaking strange languages and proclaiming the greatness of God. Peter himself then said, 'Could anyone refuse the water of baptism to these people, now they have received the Holy Spirit just as much as we have?' He then gave them orders for them to be baptised in the name of Jesus Christ. Afterwards they begged him to stay on for some days.

## **SPECIAL FEAST ST MATTHIAS, APOSTLE**

**14 MAY**

Matthias, whose name means "gift of God", was the disciple chosen to replace Judas as one of the twelve Apostles. The Acts of the Apostles state that he was also one of the 72 disciples that the Lord Jesus sent out to preach the good news. Matthias was with the Lord since His Baptism, and was "a witness to Christ's Resurrection," according to St. Peter in Acts. He remained with Jesus until His Ascension.

According to various traditions, Matthias preached in Cappadocia, Jerusalem, the shores of the Caspian Sea (in modern day Georgia) and Ethiopia. He is said to have met his death by either crucifixion in Colchis or by stoning in Jerusalem ...

He is invoked for assistance against alcoholism, and for support by recovered alcoholics.

## **A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN**

Jesus said to his disciples:  
'As the Father has loved me,  
so I have loved you.  
Remain in my love.  
If you keep my commandments  
you will remain in my love,  
just as I have kept my Father's  
commandments  
and remain in his love.  
I have told you this  
so that my own joy may be in you  
and your joy be complete.  
This is my commandment:  
love one another,  
as I have loved you.  
A man can have no greater love  
than to lay down his life for his friends.  
You are my friends,  
if you do what I command you.  
I shall not call you servants any more,  
because a servant does not know  
his master's business;  
I call you friends,  
because I have made known to you  
everything I have learnt from my Father.  
You did not choose me,  
no, I chose you;  
and I commissioned you  
to go out and to bear fruit,  
fruit that will last;  
and then the Father will give you  
anything you ask in my name.  
What I command you  
is to love one another.

## **COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL**

Today's gospel passage flows directly from the one we heard last Sunday. We continue to have the sense of eavesdropping on an intimate conversation as Jesus speaks with his disciples. It's worth recalling the setting in which Jesus opens his heart to them. Night has fallen. The disciples have been profoundly moved by Jesus' extraordinary gesture of washing their feet. They are troubled by his talk of treachery and desertion. The atmosphere is intense.

The reading as a whole may be imagined as a necklace with a string of precious stones, with each gem deserving to be inspected and admired.

Daydawn Advocacy Centre is a busy Archdiocesan agency that provides advocacy for Aboriginal people. This role works directly with the tenant advocate lawyer, supporting clients facing eviction and other issues related to rental properties. This role would suit someone with a commitment to social justice and tenant rights, experience in advocacy and an understanding of the *Residential Tenancies Act 1987 (WA)*.

### **Caritas Australia launches appeal for India**

Caritas Australia has launched an appeal to help support vulnerable communities in India as COVID-19 cases in the country continue to climb.

India's COVID-19 infections have surged past 20 million, nearly doubling in the past four months – marking the biggest increase in COVID-19 infections globally.

The country of nearly 1.4 billion people has a staggering 3.45 million active cases, although experts warn that actual numbers could be five to ten times higher than those reported.

The enormous second wave has had a devastating impact on India's healthcare system, with widespread shortages of hospital beds and oxygen.
