A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MARK

Jesus said to his disciples: 'In those days, after the time of distress, the sun will be darkened, the moon will lose its brightness, the stars will come falling from heaven and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory; then too he will send the angels to gather his chosen from the four winds, from the ends of the world to the ends of heaven.

'Take the fig tree as a parable: as soon as its twigs grow supple and its leaves come out, you know that summer is near. So with you, when you see these things happening know that he is near, at the very gates. I tell you solemnly, before this generation has passed away all these things will have taken place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

'But as for that day or hour, nobody knows it, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son; no one but the Father.

COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL

The final extract from Mark's gospel is a key section of the apocalyptic discourse in Chapter 13. God's ultimate triumph is the focus of today's reading.

The fearsome shaking of the heavens is described in language drawn from prophets. This cataclysmic event heralds the ultimate end of the world and the coming of the Son of Man, so it represents good news. The cosmic imagery is complemented by the homely parable of the fig tree coming into full bloom.

There is certainty in the assurance that in the end divine power will prevail, but what remains uncertain is when all of this will come to pass. The effect of the reading is to both warn and encourage the Christian community to live with resilient faith.

Elizabeth was born in Slovakia in 1207. She was married at the age of fourteen to Ludwig of Thuringia. They had had a happy marriage with three children until Ludwig died of the plague while on crusade leaving Elizabeth a widow at the age of 20. Elizabeth worked to protect the poor and founded orphanages and hospitals, living this life of service as a Franciscan tertiary despite the hostility of her relatives and the harshness of her confessor. She is remembered for her good-humoured resilience in adversity and for her humility in menial service of the needy.
