A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

Jesus took with him Peter and John and James and went up the mountain to pray. As he prayed, the aspect of his face was changed and his clothing became brilliant as lightning. Suddenly there were two men there talking to him; they were Moses and Elijah appearing in glory, and they were speaking of his passing which he was to accomplish in Jerusalem. Peter and his companions were heavy with sleep, but they kept awake and saw his glory and the two men standing with him. As these were leaving him, Peter said to Jesus, 'Master, it is wonderful for us to be here; so let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.' - He did not know what he was saying. As he spoke, a cloud came and covered them with shadow; and when they went into the cloud the disciples were afraid. And a voice came from the cloud saying, 'This is my Son, the Chosen One. Listen to him'. And after the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. The disciples kept silence and, at that time, told no one what they had seen.

Happy ANNIVERSARY

March 13th marks the 9th anniversary of the election of his Holiness Pope Francis as Bishop of Rome and leader of the Catholic Church.

The anniversary of the current Pope's election is a public holiday in Vatican City.

Pope Francis is the 266th Pope and replaced Pope Benedict XVI who had been pope since 2005 but had unexpectedly resigned on February 28th 2013.

Francis was born Jorge Mario Bergoglio in Buenos Aires, Argentina in 1936. Bergoglio worked briefly as a chemical technologist and nightclub bouncer before turning to the church.

He was ordained a Catholic priest in 1969 and became the Archbishop of Buenos Aires in 1998. He was made a cardinal in 2001 by Pope John Paul II.

ARCHDIOCESE OF PERTH COVID UPDATE

- Places of worship are permitted to open providing that the **two (2) square metre rule** and **150-person capacity limit is applied**.
- Physical distancing is to be observed between people of different households.
- Mask wearing is required for all adults and children in Years 3 or above.
- Parish newsletters should not be re-used. Copies to be taken home or disposed of.
