GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Many of you, like me, will remember the time when our annual "Vocations Sunday" was about God calling young people to priesthood or to life as a male or female religious. Nowadays, it is much broader than that. We are now more aware that God calls everyone to play a part in his plan for their own eternal wellbeing and that of all humanity. It might be as a married person, a single person, a male or female religious or a priest. All are vocations from God. What is important is to discover the way of life to which God is calling each of us, and to have the courage to follow that calling. And, of course, the calling might change one or more times in the course of a lifetime. So today being Vocations Sunday, we are praying for each other and for the whole Church that we will all be discerning and faithful in the way of life God in his love has marked out for us.

In the meantime, today's short gospel about the Good Shepherd is telling us something about how Jesus feels about those who believe in him and try to follow him. It is very encouraging and worth thinking about. Jesus says that he regards us who believe in him as gifts from the Father. We belong to him, and he gives us eternal life.

It is a share in the life of God which comes to its fullness after death. Meanwhile, we listen to him and follow the sound of his voice.
