Sr Myrtle and the Dominican Sisters are celebrating her Diamond Jubilee of Religious Profession on Saturday June 18 with Mass at 10 am at Our Lady of the Rosary Church. Parishioners are warmly invited to attend the Mass to pray for and give thanks for Sr Myrtle's 60 years of service to God's people.



This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year, which concludes the Easter season and celebrates the beginning of the Church.

Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after his ascension into heaven. Because Easter is a moveable feast without a fixed date, and Pentecost depends on the timing of Easter, Pentecost can fall anywhere between May 10 and June 13.

A READING FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN

Jesus said to his disciples

'If you love me you will keep my commandments.
I shall ask the Father and he will give you
another Advocate

to be with you for ever.

'If anyone loves me he will keep my word,
and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him
and make our home with him.

Those who do not love me do not keep my words.

And my word is not my own;

it is the word of the one who sent me.

I have said these things to you while still with you;

but the Advocate, the Holy Spirit,

whom the Father will send in my name,

will teach you everything

and remind you of all I have said to you'

Dear Parishioners and Visitors

One way of understanding what Pentecost is all about is to remember what Mary was told at the Annunciation, that the **Holy Spirit** would come upon her and so her child would be called 'Son of God.' Then later, when Jesus was a young man, he went out into the wilderness to listen to John the Baptist and was baptised by him.

Immediately after his baptism, while he was praying, St Luke's Gospel tells us that the **Holy Spirit** descended upon him and a voice came from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved." And in the strength of this Spirit Jesus went on to overcome the temptations of Satan and to fulfil his Father's plan for the salvation and eternal happiness of humanity.

Today we celebrate Jesus sharing that same **Holy Spirit** that was given to him with all those who believe in him. So the Spirit in whose power Mary conceived the Son of God in her womb, and in whose power Jesus overcame the power of Satan and remained faithful to his Father's will throughout his life, is shared by all of us who believe in him.

Maybe we have more in common with Jesus than we sometimes think.
