**A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL

Jesus came to a village, and a woman named Martha welcomed him into her house. She had a sister called Mary, who sat down at the Lord's feet and listened to him speaking. Now Martha who was distracted with all the serving said, 'Lord, do you not care that my sister is leaving me to do the serving all by myself? Please tell her to help me.' But the Lord answered: 'Martha, Martha,' he said, 'you worry and fret about so many things, and yet few are needed, indeed only one. It is Mary who has chosen the better part; it is not to be taken from her.'

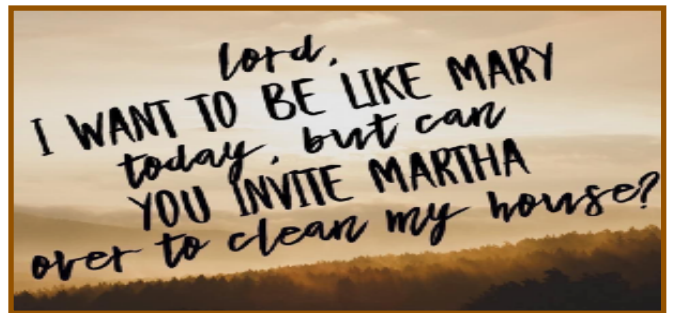
Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Today's gospel about Martha and Mary reminded me of a story I heard many years ago. I am not sure whether it was true or not. That doesn't matter. Once upon a time, a group of Christians from other Churches came to visit a Cistercian monastery. The monks were very hospitable, and at the end of the tour one of the visitors remarked, "Well, Father, we serve God in our way and you serve him in your way." But the monk replied, "I would say rather that you serve God in your way, and we serve him in his way."

Whatever about the fairness of the monk's response, isn't that exactly what is happening in the Gospel today? Martha is serving Jesus in her way. She's good in the kitchen and she likes cooking. She's preparing several dishes for Jesus, whereas, as Jesus tells her, one would be enough. She could then join her sister listening to Jesus. Mary, on the other hand is serving Jesus in the way he wants her too. She is listening.

Don't many of us sometimes fall in to the temptation of thinking we are doing what God wants us to, whereas in fact we are doing what gives us most satisfaction.
