Following the 10am Mass we will have morning tea in the Rosary Community Centre. Please bring a plate to share.



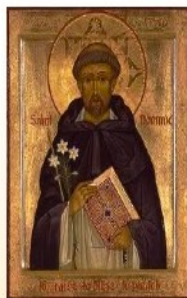
### Prayer for the Feast of St. Dominic

## Pastoral Letter on the Fifth Plenary Council of the Catholic Church in Australia

The second and final assembly of the Fifth Plenary Council of the Catholic Church in Australia has concluded. After a long and intense journey of over four years the members of the Plenary Council, lay women and men, religious sisters, brothers and priests, diocesan clergy and all of Australia's active bishops (as well as four retired bishops), met together in Sydney to formulate the response of the Catholic Church in Australia to a very important and fundamental question:

**What is God asking of us in Australia at this time?**

## Safeguarding Induction for All Church Workers

The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has broadened safeguarding to include adults at risk. ALL church workers (volunteers or paid) are to attend a 2-hour safeguarding induction. A church worker is **anyone** in the parish in **any role** – paid or voluntary.

This induction provides an overview of the Safeguarding Policies and Procedures, the role of the Parish Safeguarding Officer, and the importance of Safeguarding within the parish. You can complete the induction online on these dates: Wednesday, 17 August at 7 pm • Thursday, 25 August at 2 pm • Tuesday, 13 September at 7 pm • Wednesday, 28 September at 10 am.

## Gospel:

### A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

Jesus said to the disciples: 'You are the salt of the earth. But what if salt goes flat? How can you restore its flavour? Then it is good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot.

'You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Men do not light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket. They set it on a stand where it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, your light must shine before men so that they may see goodness in your acts and give praise to your heavenly Father.

'Do not think that I have come to abolish the law and the prophets. I have come, not to abolish them, but to fulfill them. Of this much I assure you: until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter of the law, not the smallest part of a letter, shall be done away with until it all comes true. That is why whoever breaks the least significant of these commands and teaches other to do so shall be called least in the kingdom of God. Whoever fulfils and teaches these commands shall be great in the kingdom of God.'



## SAINT MARY OF THE CROSS

AUGUST 8



The story of Australia's first official saint, Mary MacKillop (1842-1909), is well known and easily accessed. Rather than re-tell it, let Mary speak to us in her own words:

- ◆ *Believe in the whisperings of God to your own heart. (1868)*
- ◆ *Never see a need without doing something about it. (1871)*
- ◆ *Be full of forgiveness, hope and love. (1873)*
- ◆ *Try at least to excuse what you cannot understand and bear in mind that you have only to answer for your own faults. (1877)*
- ◆ *Find happiness in making others happy. (1899)*
- ◆ *Seek first the poorest and most neglected parts of God's vineyard. (1900)*

And finally to her sisters:

*Whatever troubles may be before you, accept them cheerfully, remembering whom you are trying to follow. Do not be afraid. Love one another, bear with one another, and let charity guide you in all your life. (1909)*
