A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

The tax collectors and the sinners were all seeking the company of Jesus to hear what he had to say, and the Pharisees and the scribes complained. 'This man' they said 'welcomes sinners and eats with them.' So he spoke this parable to them:

'What man among you with a hundred sheep, losing one, would not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness and go after the missing one till he found it? And when he found it, would he not joyfully take it on his shoulders and then, when he got home, call together his friends and neighbours? "Rejoice with me," he would say, "I have found my sheep that was lost." In the same way, I tell you, there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one repentant sinner than over ninety-nine virtuous men who have no need of repentance.

'Or again, what woman with ten drachmas would not, if she lost one, light a lamp and seek out the house and search thoroughly until she found it? And then, when she had found it call together her friends and neighbours? "Rejoice with me," she would say "I have found the drachma I lost." In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing among the angels of God over one repentant sinner.

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Today's marvellous story begins with religious leaders complaining that Jesus welcomes sinners and eats with them. And it turns out to be true, he does. And he tells three famous stories which change the focus from an emphasis on sin and forgiveness to being lost and being found, followed by a celebration.



Perhaps the best way to absorb the important message of this gospel is to keep dwelling on the fact that it is basically about what God is like, that is, how Jesus wants us to think about his Father and how his Father thinks about us.
