## A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

This is how Jesus Christ came to be born. His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph; but before they came to live together she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph, being a man of honour and wanting to spare her publicity, decided to divorce her informally. He had made up his mind to do this when the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, and said 'Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because she has conceived what is in her by the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son and you must name him Jesus, because he is the one who is to save his people from their sins.' Now all this took place to fulfil the words spoke by the Lord through the prophet:

The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son  
and they will call him Emmanuel,

a name which means 'God-is-with-us'. When Joseph woke up he did what the angel of the Lord had told him to do: he took his wife to his home.

*Dear Parishioners and Visitors*

*It's a funny thing, but in this last week before Christmas, when many of us are very busy, the gospel talks about sleeping and dreaming. The key person today is St. Joseph. He is given the solution to his greatest problem by an angel in a dream. He has suddenly become aware that Mary, his betrothed, is pregnant, and he knows he is not the father. But the angel tells him that the child has been conceived by the Holy Spirit and will save his people from their sins.*

*And that's not all. After Jesus' birth the angel returns to warn the sleeping Joseph to escape from Herod in Jerusalem by travelling south into Egypt, and then later still to assure him that it is now safe to return to Israel, since Herod is dead. Finally, the angel warns Joseph in a dream to avoid further persecution by settling in Galilee rather than further south in Judea.*

*Pope Francis has an image of the sleeping Joseph in his apartment in the Vatican - so he told the Philippine people during a visit a few years ago. The Pope relies on St Joseph to help him with his problems. He thinks dreaming can play an important role in our lives, especially when we dream about the presence of God in other people's lives and in the world around us. Hopefully, we can make time for a little bit of dreaming this week. And we do not have to be asleep to have such dreams.*
