
















A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

The eleven disciples set out for Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had arranged to meet them. When they saw him they fell down before him, though some hesitated. Jesus came up and spoke to them. He said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.

Dear Parishioners and Visitors

From beginning to end of Matthew's Gospel, Jesus is portrayed as Emmanuel, "God with us". From the time of the angel's announcement to Joseph that Mary had conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, to Jesus' farewell to his disciples in today's gospel, Emmanuel is the name given to Jesus.

But we might be left asking, who is the God who has promised to be always with us? Is he the judge who will finally come in glory, or is he the servant, who identifies himself with the little ones,

the poor and hungry, the afflicted and the needy, even at the last judgment? So it seems that the best way to ensure a welcome into the Father's kingdom is to act mercifully towards the afflicted.

There are, therefore, two visions of God in Matthew's gospel – the one who reaches out and serves the afflicted and sinful through Jesus, and the one to whom only the virtuous have access, and whose principal function is to judge.

However, the overall vision of God in this gospel is a God who has forestalled judgment by coming among us in the burden bearing person of his Son: "Come to me all you who labour and I will give you rest". Fr. Tom.
