This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year, which concludes the Easter season and celebrates the beginning of the Church.

Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after his ascension into heaven. Because Easter is a moveable feast without a fixed date, and Pentecost depends on the timing of Easter, Pentecost can fall anywhere between May 10 and June 13.

29 May: Mary, Mother of the Church

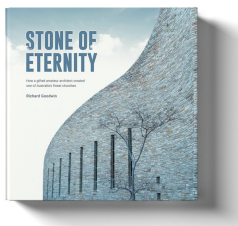

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

One way of understanding what Pentecost is all about is to remember what Mary was told at the Annunciation, that the **Holy Spirit** would come upon her and so her child would be called 'Son of God.' Then later, when Jesus was a young man, he went out into the wilderness to listen to John the Baptist and be baptised by him. Immediately after his baptism, while he was praying, St Luke's Gospel tells us that the **Holy Spirit** descended upon him and a voice came from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved." And in the strength of this Spirit Jesus went on to overcome the temptations of Satan and to fulfil his Father's plan for the wellbeing and final happiness of humanity.

The point is that today we celebrate Jesus sharing that same **Holy Spirit** that was given to him with all those who believe in him. So, the Spirit in whose power Mary conceived the Son of God in her womb, and in whose power Jesus overcame the power of Satan and remained faithful to his Father's will throughout his life, is shared by all of us who believe in him.

The presence of the **Holy Spirit** within each of us is actually the continuing influence in our lives of the transforming power of the risen Christ who gives the Spirit to those who are open to receiving his gifts. It is not a gift to be kept wrapped up inside us, but a divine power and divine life, in fact, a divine Person enabling us to continue the mission of Jesus on earth. Basically, that means loving our neighbour, especially those neighbours who most need the compassion of Jesus, which is what we have to offer.

Maybe we have more in common with Jesus than we sometimes think.
