A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

Jesus said to the chief priests and the elders of the pope, 'What is your opinion? A man had two sons. He went and said to the first, "My boy, you go and work in the vineyard today." He answered, "I will not go", but afterwards thought better of it and went. The man then went and said the same thing to the second who answered, "Certainly, sir", but did not go. Which of the two did the father's will?' 'The first' they said. Jesus said to them, 'I tell you solemnly, tax collectors and prostitutes are making their way into the kingdom of God before you. For John came to you, a pattern of true righteousness, but you did not believe him, and yet the tax collectors and prostitutes did. Even after seeing that, you refused to think better of it and believe him.'

COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

One of the best things about being human is that we can change, not only our mind, but our whole way of life and way of seeing things and people. At its best we call it growth, becoming more human, and therefore more like God, in whose image we are made. Most of us probably do not want to stay exactly the way we are now for all eternity. So we pray that we will be made into fit company for God and his angels and saints.

I think that is what today's gospel is at least partly about. The first son changed his mind and decided to do what his father told him. The second one, I suspect, never really intended going to work in his father's vineyard. He just said yes to keep his father quiet and made no change in his mind or anywhere else.

Jesus goes on to mention the outcasts of his own society who often were more accepting of John the Baptist's preaching conversion than the religious leaders. That is why the former were ahead of the latter in getting entry into the kingdom. Jesus also noticed that he himself got a more positive response from people on the margins, whereas those who appeared religious from the start may never appreciate the depth of God's mercy and so come to know him as he really is.

Eternal life will be God's gift in abundance to those who have grown, sometimes over a lifetime, into the openness to receive it.
