JESUS BECOMES OUR LADDER BETWEEN HEAVEN AND EARTH

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Christmas is the celebration of the wedding between heaven and earth. In the Old Testament we read about Jacob's vision, more than a thousand years before Jesus' birth, of a ladder between heaven and earth with angels continually ascending and descending between the two. But now heaven and earth, God and us, are united in one man and one flesh in Jesus.

Our Mass is the celebration of this wedding between heaven and earth. It is at Mass that, as members of Christ's Body on earth we hold a conversation with God in the Liturgy of the Word. And it is at Mass, in the Liturgy of the Eucharist, that Christ's self-offering to the Father becomes present to us. But now it is our self-offering as well, because we are one flesh in him.

And so the Cross, the altar of his sacrifice, becomes the table of his feast at which we eat and drink. The Cross is the altar on which Christ offers Himself to the Father, but it is also the table from which we feast.

MARIST REUNION

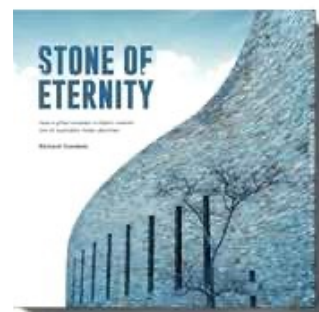
Wednesday 24 January 2024

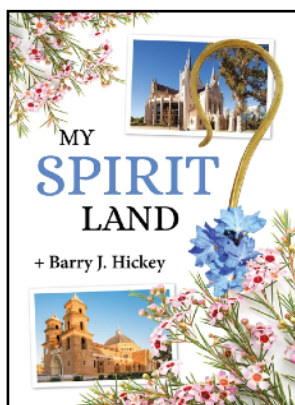
STONE OF ETERNITY
