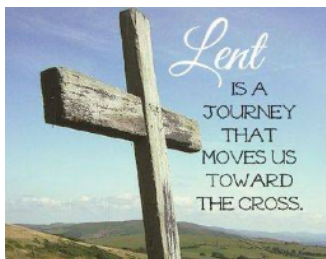
**COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL**
