A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MARK

Jesus took with him Peter and James and John and led them up a high mountain where they could be alone by themselves. There in their presence he was transfigured: his clothes became dazzlingly white, whiter than any earthly bleacher could make them. Elijah appeared to them with Moses; and they were talking with Jesus. Then Peter spoke to Jesus, 'Rabbi,' he said 'it is wonderful for us to be here; so let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.' He did not know what to say; they were so frightened. And a cloud came, covering them in shadow; and there came a voice from the cloud, 'This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him.' Then suddenly, when they looked round, they saw no one with them any more but only Jesus.

As they came down the mountain he warned them to tell no one who they had seen, until after the Son of Man had risen from the dead. They observed the warning faithfully, though among themselves they discussed what 'rising from the dead' could mean.

COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

It's a big event in our lives when we decide to reveal ourselves at a deep level to another person. Sometimes we may come to regret it. At other times it will bring us a great feeling of fulfilment.

Just before Jesus' Transfiguration, related in today's gospel, Jesus told his disciples that he would have to endure great suffering and rejection and be killed. But then at the Transfiguration he decided to show himself even more deeply to his closest disciples, Peter, James and John. They were given a glimpse of his glory as God's Son.

But does Jesus still reveal himself at a deep level to us today? The Scriptures say he does, especially, but not only, in the poor and needy. And he still reveals his glory as God in all the beauty and goodness of his creatures, because they were created through him, with him and in him as God's Son.

The main point is that in Jesus God Himself really did enter into our damaged, suffering and sinful world. And He is still here, wanting to reveal His healing power through and in us. God is still at work showing himself to the extent that we are open to his presence.
