GOOD FRIDAY HOLY LAND COLLECTION

The annual collection for the support of the church in the Holy Land will take place on Good Friday, March 29th. This collection promotes the missionary work of the Church in the Holy Land by providing welfare assistance to local Christians in areas such as health, education, employment, housing. Parishes, and orphanages. It is also used to maintain over 70 churches and shrines associated with the life of Jesus. Due to the ongoing war, the Church and people of the Holy Land are still struggling with reduced income due to fewer pilgrims and lower church attendance around the world.

The reality for the Holy Land mission is that they will continue to face challenges financial and spiritual and so we again ask Catholics around the world again to be as generous as possible, with their financial support as well as the spiritual support. Please remember the Christians of the Holy Land on Good Friday. Thank you.

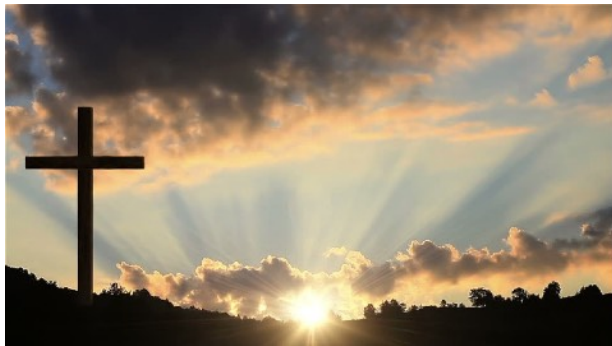

COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL

Dear Parishioners and Visitors.

In the gospel again today we have the report of a seemingly simple event in Jesus' life among us. A couple of foreigners, two men from outside Jesus' own Jewish nation, come to Philip, one of Jesus' disciples with a Greek name. They tell him they want to "see Jesus". Philip then goes and tells the other disciple with a Greek name, Andrew, and together they go and tell Jesus.

Nothing very exciting there, we might think. But for Jesus, it is. He takes it to mean that his "good news" from God has now reached beyond the borders of Israel. His mission is therefore coming to a close. It will end with the offering of his life to the Father on the Cross - the grain falling to the ground and dying to give birth to new life. In Jesus' case it will be a new and glorious life with the Father, which will then become available to his followers.

So Jesus offers us a share in his own triumph over death - a life of eternal happiness with God and each other. It is all gift. In the meantime we are asked to share what we already have with those who are not so fortunate.
