## A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN

Jesus said to his disciples:

'I am the true vine

and my Father is the vinedresser.

Every branch in me that bears no fruit

he cuts away,

and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes

to make it bear even more.

You are pruned already,

by means of the word that I have spoken to you.

Make your home in me, as I make mine in you.

#### **COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL**

#### Dear Parishioners and Visitors

I think it's true that most of us like hearing about ourselves. Today's gospel is trying to help us understand ourselves, to know who we really are, and how we can make the most of all the possibilities open to us. So it should be good news, helping us to understand who we are at a deeper than usual level.

The essential message seems to be that we are part of something much bigger than ourselves — the Body of Christ, the vine which is Christ, planted and nurtured by the Father. Jesus is offering us a new way of seeing ourselves. According to his way of thinking, what we can achieve does not depend so much on our individual, natural abilities, but on our trust in the Father for whom nothing is impossible, and nothing more important than nurturing the vine which is his Son, to which all of us are attached.

That helps us to understand why Jesus can say: "If you remain in me... you may ask what you will and you shall get it." To the extent that we are part of the vine which is Jesus, our prayers are his prayers!
