A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MARK

Jesus showed himself to the Eleven, and said to them, 'Go out to the whole world, proclaim the Good News to all creation. He who believes and is baptised will be saved; he who does not believe will be condemned. These are the signs that will be associated with believers: in my name they will cast out devils; they will have the gift of tongues; they will pick up snakes in their hands, and be unharmed should they drink deadly poison; they will lay their hands on the sick, who will recover.'

And so the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven: there at the right hand of God he took his place, while they, going out, preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and informing the word by the signs that accompanied it.

COMMENTARY ON THE GOSPEL

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

At the Transfiguration, Jesus gave Peter, James and John a glimpse of the glory that he was to receive after his Ascension to his Father in Heaven, which we are celebrating today. Jesus, the Son of God, Second Person of the Blessed Trinity, returns to His Father who had sent him into the world as one of us. Now he returns, still one of us, but with his humanity glorified.

Does that mean he is no longer among us here on earth? A moment's reflection is all we need to answer that. The Eucharist is given to us precisely as the great sign that Jesus remains with us.

Likewise, the Church believes that when the Scriptures are read to us Jesus is present and speaking to us. And yet again, next Sunday, Pentecost, we will be celebrating Jesus sending the Holy Spirit, His Spirit, into our hearts and minds to live within us, as in a temple, according to Scripture. Finally, Jesus tells us confidently that we keep meeting him in the poor and those in any kind of need, and in all our neighbours. So there are many ways in which Jesus remains present to us.

The challenge that comes with today's Good News is threefold.

Firstly, how do we grow in awareness of Jesus' constant, loving and powerful presence in our lives and the lives of others?

Secondly, how do we become ourselves a more convincing visible presence of Jesus as members of his body on earth? And finally, how do we become more conscious that the glory Jesus now has as man in heaven is exactly what he longs to share with each of us.
